Dear Sir or Madam,  
I am in full support of the Application.

The tree in question is a park tree and unsuitable for a small urban garden. The roots of the tree are severely damaging the adjacent garden wall. 37 Camden Mews NW1 9BY is underpinned and perhaps protected from the roots.

The neighbouring properties, built on London clay are very susceptible to subsidence. The Tree of Heaven (T1) is likely to cause problems in the future.

I live at 188 Camden Rd which backs on to 37 Camden Mews NW1 9BY and am most directly affected by Tree of Heaven (T1).

In recent years more and larger branches have been falling off Tree of Heaven (T1).

If 1 of these branches fell on to 1 of my grandchildren playing in my garden it could cause serious injury even death: something we don't want even to contemplate.

For the above reasons I support the application.  
It is essential that this tree is felled.
