5.7 TOWNSCAPE STRATEGY

Townscape Impact Assessment

The area around the site is characterized by a mix of low to mid-rise buildings, with some structures adjacent to the site being even larger. The urban environment maintains a pedestrian-friendly scale, fostering a lively street atmosphere and providing a backdrop to the diverse cultural and commercial activities in the area.

The scheme has been designed to minimise the wider visual impact to the local area and in particular the adjacent conservation areas. A Visual Impact Appraisal has been prepared by Montagu Evans on behalf of the Applicant. The study area for the VIA includes both the Site and its wider context radiating from its boundary.

This section summarises the selected views that have been tested. Each view shows the before and after, with 'wirelines' used where sight of the building is obscured. Further analyses of the view can be found in the Visual Impact Appraisal.








View 02 This viewpoint is located 50m to the southwest of the site on Shaftesbury Avenue, at the junction with Earlham Street.








