Whilst the application stresses that :

quote...

... there will not be any noise affecting the neighbours.

...unquote

Nevertheless from the photo provided they appear to be enclosed, with a somewhat insubstantial plastic corrugated cover - there is a history of shops in England's Lane attempting to place air conditioning/extractor units within the 15ft space which separates their rears abutting Elizabeth Mews.

It is not clear how these units will operate within the constrains of the very small enclosed space and if they become exposed sometime in the future, noise would excape magnified by the well into the surrounding areas.

It should be stressed that No 8, 9 & 1o Elizabeth Mews have all bedrooms at the rear and are particularly exposed to any such noise.

What cast iron assurance can the applicant give that no noise will affect the surrounding areas when the units might become exposed?
