We think Objection is reasonable.

The colour of new material should harmonise with the context, whether of the host building or the setting, particularly green environment.

Almost all extensions and outbuildings proposed seek to limit impact on their surroundings.

If a bright colour such as that proposed is permitted, it could set a precedent for any local context or simply a 'different' appearance. We could be looking at growth of 'differences' unrelated to context, competing, strident etc.
