I was surprised, and not a little offended, to receive notification of this planning application - not least because the applicant, Mrs. Sheila Peacock, never even had the courtesy to email me about it, let alone come and consult with me or seek my co-operation with her request.

Mrs. Peacock seems to be posing as the owner of the tree she's referring to. She's not. The tree is on my property, and furthermore offers no kind of hazard or damage to the adjoining Farrier Street properties. Being to the south, it doesn't even shade them. It is, of course, in a Conservation area.

As for having this and the other trees in the street pruned: The last time the Origin Housing Association were allowed to carry out such work they drastically overstepped their brief, threatening the health of the trees, risking die-back and ruining their attractiveness.

If Mrs. Peacock wishes to have trimmed the ends of those branches that slightly overhang the boundary line between my garden and the car park, I would appreciate her discussing it with me and seeking my cooperation with her request.

I wish to emphatically reject this application.
