				At the moment the bins are on a pathway, between two walls, leading from the street side gate. As such they present various health and safety risks.	
				1. In the event of a fire or other serious incident within the block they would impede the exit from the building.	
				2. They have to be moved every time someone wants to make a large delivery or bring children in a pram onto the premises. Some of the bins, when full, are very heavy and could cause an injury if they fall.	
				3. Foxes can access the bins at times and spread the contents over the garden area.	
				Not only do I think the bin area is essential to minimise the above risks, I also believe that Camden should send officers to visit the site with a view to placing an Enforcement Order on the current position of the bins. To this end, on the 4th March, I emailed building.control@camden.gov.uk to ask them to visit but I have yet to receive a reply.
