1 Reasons for granting approval of details:

Condition 4 requires a sample panel of the proposed facing brickwork and pointing to be erected on site. The applicant has provided such a sample panel constructed of the proposed rural multi brick with running bond and lime mortar. Photographs have been provided against the original brickwork.

The proposed brickwork and mortar are considered a suitable choice for the proposed single storey extension in relation to the host building and surrounding context and would ensure high quality design is secured

throughout the development, as such it is recommended that condition 4 is discharged.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the appearance of the streetscene or this part of the conservation area or on neighbouring amenity.
