Dear Blythe and Camden Council,

I hope this email finds you well. I am the owner of 25 Hampstead Lane.

I am writing today to bring your attention to the ongoing works at 23a Hampstead Lane, N6 4RT by Andrew Thornton and Eudora Pascall.

There are currently 2 men working to erect a boundary fence between flat a and b instructed by A&E. The workmen have already chainsawed and hacked away at a very old tree that belongs to Janice in flat b, which I believe is without her consent.

I can see an application online for tree works to be assessed by the council that was only submitted a couple of days ago. I wanted to make you aware this work has now been fully undertaken and completed, leaving the tree and the living plant matter attached all severely compromised. I watched with my own eyes as the men just tossed the cut branches back into Janice's garden.

These actions also impact my own home, as much of the living plant matter is growing on our shared fence, which to date has been a lush and abundant feature of our garden. The works already carried out at 23a to prune and fell this tree will now surely cause the plant to die, leaving us no choice but to cut away the branches and leaves on our side.

It's very concerning that works continue to proceed at this property that impact on so many of the residents and we don't seem to have a say in the matter.
