I am a horticulturist who works for the owner of Manor Lodge, in NW3 1BB place.

There is a Lime tree, that is hollow, it grows next to the neighbour property, and it is very likely that will fall on the next door property causing a considerable damage and costs to my client.

I seek a permission for the tree to be felled as the tree is weakened by the fact the core of the tree is hollow and it is quite weak.

With the odd weather patterns and winds that are occurring in this area on a regular basis the tree is in danger of collapsing on the neighbouring property.

Please let me know if you need any more info about that, and also if a tree officer needs to see the site.

I work in the garden on Wednesdays from 11am-3pm.
