Assessment

A s.211 notification has been received to carry out works to six trees in the rear garden of a residential property that is situated within the Camden Square Conservation Area.

The proposed works are mostly small scale canopy reductions (max. 2m) and one tree removal.

The Council received one comment (not objection) regarding this s211 notification which asked that more of the canopy of the Arizona Cypress (ref hh12) be removed as part of the works.

As the Council is not responsible for the works nor can compel the applicant and their agent to carry out certain works, no objection to the works can be made.

It is not expedient for the Council to serve a tree preservation order to protect the tree.

The Council does not object to the proposed works.
