Dear Sirs

We are in receipt of your letter regarding the application to fell the poplar tree at 35B Fairhazel Gardens. We live at 35C and are strongly in support of this application.

We are very concerned that the tree is in poor condition. It has a large hole at the fork in the trunk which is catching water and this has a large fungus growing in it. If the tree or part of it were to fall it could partially demolish both our house and number 35B and crush people or cars on Fairhazel Gardens. We have written to the Council a couple of times to express our concern but with no response. We will hold Camden Council fully responsible for any injury or damage should the tree or part of it fall.

The tree continues to damage the boundaries of our property and that of no 35B. We have had to take down the brickwork adjacent to the tree and replace it with a (we hope temporary) fence and the boundary wall to no 35B has been rebuilt a number of times after the tree has caused structural failure.

We urge you to grant this application.
