The BCAAC has no strong objection to make on the above Planning Application but would like to document these comments on the proposal to divide Unit 2 into two separate units, a & b. The symmetry of the upper floors of the building, which has preserved its original architecture & is uniform in its design, will be further compromised. The materials used (eg. aluminium doors) for these shop floor fronts along High Holborn are often inappropriate & do not match the preserved upper floors. This lack of respect to the preserved upper floors along High Holborn has too often been the case & needs attention.
