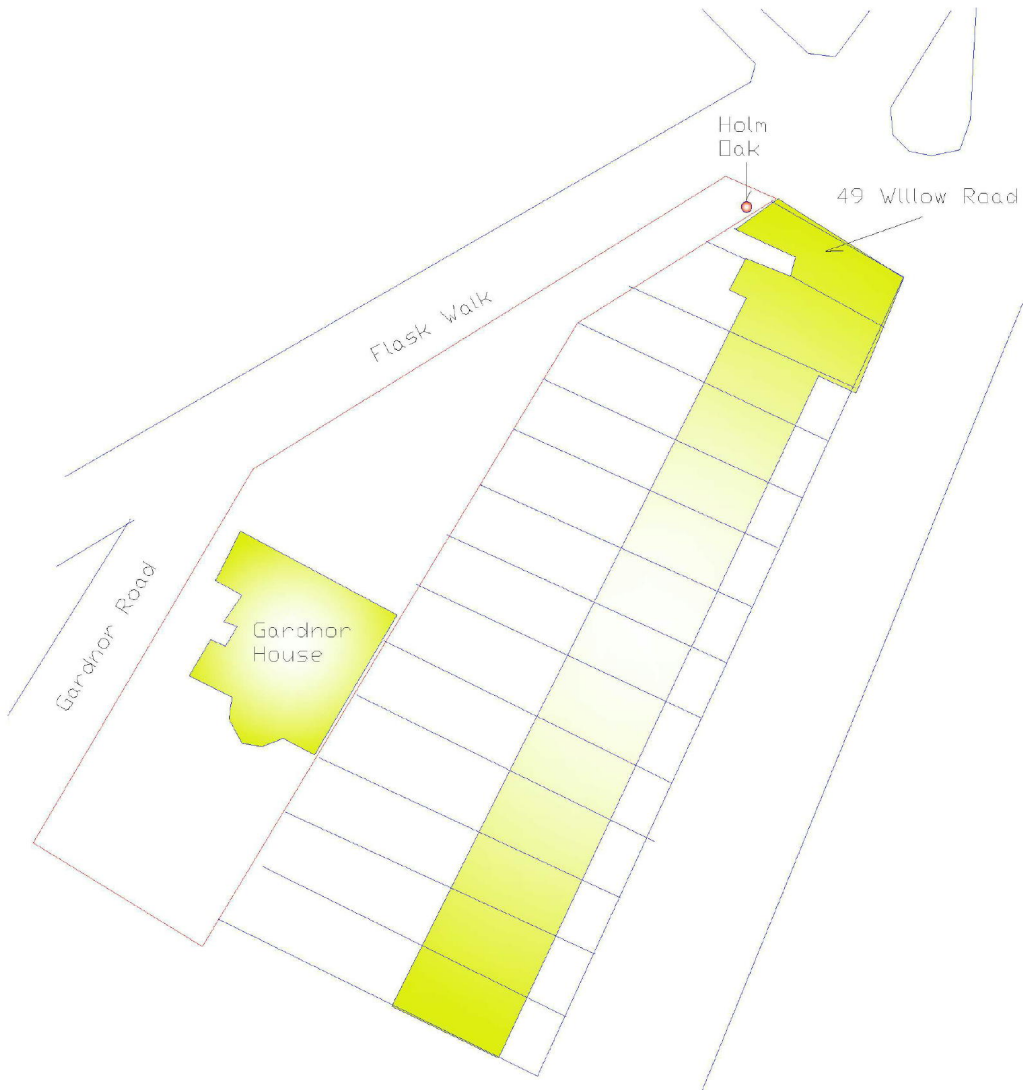

**TPO application to prune Holm Oak  
at Gardner House, Gardner Road, NW3 1HA.**





The owner of number 49 Willow Road is nearing completion of major building works. This includes reinstatement of the existing balcony underneath the Holm Oak. The photograph shows significant Pigeon manure on the balcony. Pigeon manure is known to be harmful. Pigeons are definitely not rare.





The owner of number 49 Willow Road is keen to dissuade Pigeons from nesting in this Holm Oak. The red line represents a reduction of circa 2 metres – this can be achieved and maintain flowing lines of the crown.

This application is for LPA consent to reduce the southern crown by 2 metres.

Whilst it is appreciated that the tree overhangs the balcony (and boundary) by a considerable amount this small amount of pruning will help the owner of number 49 in his efforts to dissuade Pigeons from nesting in the tree in the next season.

There is pruning history in planning case files at the Borough.  
These are notices to reduce the crown by 1 metre; 2023/2590/T and 2024/1224/T.  
To reduce the crown by 3 metres 2019/1636/T.
