I have previously objected to this application, but omitted further information regarding this flawed proposal. The erection of a single storey house in a back garden and subsequent destruction of some trees in the garden, including a Lawsons Cypress which is listed as near threatened on the Global UCN reform list of threatened species. These beautiful trees in the garden form a canopy in the garden and the destruction of these will rob many species of birds of their habitat, bats fly from the trees in the dusk in the late spring/summer flying close to our mansion block catching aphids, moths. Swifts come in the spring/summer feeding on aphids from trees. The trees have a large variety of insects, bees, wasps and provide late food from the ivy in late autumn.

I am so concerned at the loss of green assets in this area and the overdevelopment of this back garden in a conservation area, and request that mine and other residents concerns are taken into account.
