I wish to add my objection to this development.

These flats are in a conservation area and adding another floor to every block may set an undesirable precedent. Beyond that, the nature and location of the proposed new flats makes them of very high potential value. I understand that they meet certain criteria for Camden in terms of desired dwelling mix but these flats will very likely be bought by investors as assets rather than homes for Camden families.
