Remove T1, a Tree of Heaven (Ailanthus altissima) due to it being an invasive species (https://www.nonnativespecies.org/non-native-species/information-portal/view/101, https://www.woodlands.co.uk/blog/flora-and-fauna/the-tree-of-heaven-2/), causing subsidence to two walls (an internal wall and the wall adjacent to the pavement of Haverstock Hill), and a lean of approx 35 degrees towards the residents parked cars, which can be seen in a number of the attached photos.

It has suckered along the raised bed it is growing in, and dominated the remaining foilage causing most of it to die. This has since been cleared, but nothing new has been planted due to the tree putting out chemicals in the ground that inhibits other plants germinating and growing, known as allelopathy (See above web links)

In the Photo titled 'Wall cracking' a crack can be seen running from the top down to the pavement, generally through the mortar, but also through some of the bricks. This indicates some form of subscidence/heave, and with T1 being the closest tree, which can be seen in the background of the photo, it is the likely culprit.

There is a listed wall and building to the north of the tree, adjacent to the pavement as can be seen in the sketch plan.

Once the tree has been felled and the roots removed, new trees will be planted. These will be native British species as outlined by the Woodland Trust (https://www.woodlandtrust.org.uk/trees-woods-and-wildlife/british-trees/native-trees/). Ideally 2-4 new trees, depending on stock and size, will be planted to maintain the green frontage inline with the Parkhill and Upper Park Conservation Area appraisal and management strategy, and too enchance the streetscape.

142 is also noted as having neither a negative or positive imapct to the character or appearence of the area, so new planting of native trees would help enchance the character of the streetscape in regards to this property.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.

- mark the position of the tree(s) to which you want to carry out work and identify them by the number shown in the Tree Preservation Order where possible; if you use a different number, please make sure that this can be matched with your description of the tree(s)
- if there are many trees on the site, make clear which tree(s) are included in this application by:
 - $\circ~$ marking all trees on the plan, but only numbering those to which you want to carry out work
 - $\circ\;$ showing the approximate distance between the application tree(s) and buildings
 - o adding other relevant features on the site (e.g. greenhouse, paths)
