The applicant has submitted three slate samples:

Canadian Glendyne slate New Welsh slate Reclaimed Welsh slate

Upon assessment, is has been agreed that the New Welsh slate tiles are the closest match to the existing roof tiles and that these shall be used to repair the roof.

Photos of the approved slates are included in the list of approved drawings.

The proposed works will not harm the special interest of the grade-II-listed building.

. The site's planning history has been taken into account in making this decision.
