## Proposal:

Variation of condition 2 (approved plans) of planning permission 2023/2863/P granted on 28/12/2023 for "Construction of single storey rear extension. Enlargement of rear dormer window. Replacement of the existing front bay windows to match the existing with double glazing"; namely to replace two front elevation windows into a singular double height window. Drawing Nos: AL(02)01 Rev C; AL(03)01 Rev C

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed two storey window, by virtue of its scale, design and siting, would appear as a prominent and incongruous addition that would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the host property and the Redington Frognal Conservation Area. As such, the proposed development would be contrary to Policies D1 (Design) and Policy D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
