(TPO REF 9H-T29) FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Horse Chestnut (T1) - Raise crown over No.1 Windmill Hill western crown by means of removing one low branch back to main stem union, which is approx. 20cm in diameter at point of union. Raise low crown skirt (secondary & tertiary branches only) by approx. 1.5m over Windmill Hill and Bolton House where required to balance. Thin crown density throughout by 20%. Reduce over extended lateral and sub lateral growth to the western half of the crown (over Windmill Hill) by approx. 1.5m back into main crown structure. Reduce 1 x over extended limb to the east over Bolton House by approx. 1.5m, back into main crown line.

(TPO REF 9H-T30 1 x Horse Chestnut (T2) - Raise crown over No.1 Windmill Hill by approx. 1.5m.
