West Hampstead Square is a car free development yet there has been reported abuse of the car parking provided for disabled residents since the outset with the commercial units marketed with parking spaces (despite not being businesses that would seemingly require vehicles) and places being advertised for parking or the possibility of parking being arranged (indicating a work-around of the car free status. There would seem to be no valid business case for why a local estate agent needs parking for four vehicles - the site is highly accessible, no heavy loads are moved and no information is given as to the average journey undertaken by the estate agency - likely to be very small for carrying out their work as it is a local branch so why can't alternative non-car transport be used (foot, cycle, scooter?).
