The ideal candidate will play a crucial role in safeguarding sensitive data in Camden schools, supporting the efficient use of Microsoft Office 365 and Google Workspace.

- Investigate security alerts/incidents and breaches and respond promptly to mitigate potential threats.
- •Implement security measures for Microsoft Office 365 and Google Workspace environments.
- •Perform regular risk assessments to identify potential vulnerabilities and strategize their mitigation, ensuring potential security gaps are identified and addressed.
- •Collaborate with IT teams to ensure secure configuration and management of cloud-based platforms.
- •Work closely with other departments to ensure alignment of security measures with organizational goals.
- •Develop and enforce security policies and procedures related to Office 365 and Google Workspace usage.
- •Provide guidance on security awareness and best practices for using Office 365 and Google Workspace securely.

- •Generate security reports and metrics for both technical and non-technical for management and stakeholders.

Work environment

This will be a hybrid role where you will work from our main offices, 5PS, in Kings Cross and be expected to work at least one day a week in the office, with Tuesday the day when Digital & Data Services are expected to be in. This is a full-time permanent role, standard working hours are between 0800 to 1700 hours, Monday to Friday, and a successful candidate is free to flex their day around these hours.

You will report directly to the Security Operations Manager. And additionally, reporting responsibilities to the Schools' IT Service Manager in regard to specific tasks and roles. This role will require building relationships across corporate, supporting people and supporting communities' services to drive the implementation of and compliance with data standards and improve data literacy.
