Erection of a single storey extension to replace the existing condenser unit housing on the roof (granted approval under ref. 2013/6192/P) and refurbishment of the existing building.

The application site is a three storey commercial building on the north side of Stephen Mews in the Charlotte Street Conservation Area. The surrounding area has a mainly commercial character.

12 Stephen Mews is a concrete frame building faced with London Stock coloured Brick with slender concrete cills to the top and bottom of the fenestration within which white painted metal-framed single-glazed 'Crittall' windows sit. The building was constructed in the late 1950's and was clearly designed as a warehouse with a single stair and adjacent loading doors on each floor facing the mews. The current use of the building is seemingly Class E and this will not be changing.
