Condition 15 of planning permission 2018/4449/P requires that prior to commencement of works, details are submitted demonstrating how trees to be retained on and off site will be protected during construction work, which should follow guidelines and standards set out in BS5837:2012 "Trees in Relation to Construction" and should include details of appropriate working processes in the vicinity of trees, a tree protection plan and details of an auditable system of site monitoring, which is considered acceptable to the local planning authority.

The Simon Jones Associates Abrboricultural Method Statement dated March 2024 ref: SJA ams 23326-01 is sufficient to demonstrate how the trees to be retained will be protected during the implementation of the scheme. Consequently the details can be discharged in accordance with the terms of the condition.
