	Case officer's commentary on ground of objection:								
	1) There have been several planning applications made since the original development was granted (2018/6016/P). As 18 Vine Hill is in a Conservation Area, we post site notices near the site. A press notice is also displayed in								

the Camden New Journal. The noise and dust are an Environmental Health issue and not a Planning one.

- 2) This comment does not directly relate to the current application. If the planters are located on the building forecourt this would be a civil matter. If the planters are placed on the highway this would be a matter for the highways authority.
- 3) This application relates the changes to the entrance only, damage caused as a result of the main development (reference: 2018/6016/P) should be managed through the Construction Management Plan.
