Objection.

The Committee noted that this turkey oak is important in the townscape of Park Village West, linking the street with the Picturesque landscape gardens.

We have considered the arboricultural report on the health of the tree by Crown Consultants and advise that their option for the reduction of the overall canopy with annual decay detection would be the preferred option in terms of preserving the special significance of the Listed Buildings and their setting, and in preserving the character and appearance of the conservation area. We would object to the felling of the tree.
