Application 2024/1938/P: 36B Hollycroft Avenue – objection to use of non-traditional materials

The property at 36 Hollycroft Avenue is a non-designated heritage asset, designed by CH Saunders and built by William James King, as listed in section 6.1 Inventory of Designated and Non-Designated Heritage Assets (page 83) of the Neighbourhood Plan.

The traditional boundary treatment is a low brick wall with a hedge behind it and timber gates as pedestrian entrances. Metal and glass are not sympathetic to the Arts and Crafts garden suburb conservation area. However, a solid timber gate would be more discreet and in keeping with the conservation area and would provide the privacy that is sought.
