2024/2788/P	Douglas Moffat	15/07/2024 17:33:32	INT	<p>I am concerned about the lack of open consultation of and notification to the residents of Lulot Gardens on the Whittington Estate with regard to this planning application.</p> <p>I note that once again the Highgate Neighbourhood Forum and The Highgate Conservation Society have received notification and consultation priority and not those in the immediate vicinity who are most likely to be affected by any change to the present installations and associated works undertaken.</p> <p>I strongly object to the prioritisation of both these groups as neither has any affiliation with the Whittington Estate Residents and Tennants association nor does either consider or consult with Whittington Estate residents with regard to developments in the proximity.</p> <p>In particular - the recent works involving the installation of new generator and subsation in car park south and associated groundworks and temporary (2year) installation of partacabins and resulting builders yard: No consultation of, or notification to Whittington Estate residents nor TRA was ever given, and the resulting 2 year project was a very distressing time.</p> <p>With this in mind, I am objecting to the above planning application until suitable consultation has taken place with the Residents of Lulot Gardens, of the Whittington estate.</p> <p>Having looked on line, there are no plans or drawings in evidence of the coming works. A description of intent is given with regard to BLOCK M. There is no clear indication as to where Block M might be.</p> <p>At present, it is beholden to Camden residents to seek out planning applications that may have some bearing on their daily lives. Not everyone is aware of this, nor does everyone have the means or ability to do so. A written letter should be mailed to those who may be affected.</p> <p>Both Camden Planning department and The Highgate Mental Health trustees are fully aware of the upset and distress caused to residents during 2022 - 2024 with the works undertaken in Highgate West South carpark; for some - with regard to the newly installed generator, the issues are still ongoing.</p> <p>Both Trustees and Planning departments arer fully aware of the proximity of Lulot estate housing, yet consistently fail to notify or provide information to these residents.</p> <p>As stated, until such information and plans are fully divulged, and the considerations of the residents of Lulot Gradens taken into account, then I object to the above application.</p>
