T1 Cherry Tree: I understand that this could do with some reduction but 3m would be far too much

T2 Robinia: this is a magnificent tree and I cannot see any reason to get rid of it particularly in a conservation area where wildlife is supposed to be protected

T3 Sycamore: again 3m is too much

T4 Yew: again 3m is too much
