I have conducted an inspection of an oak tree on the property in the presence of the property owner. The tree has been heavily infested with termites, making it a significant hazard. Based on my experience, it is imperative that this tree be promptly removed.

One of the most prominent findings of the inspection was the presence of mud tubes ascending the bark. Termites construct these tubes using soil, wood particles, and saliva to create protective passageways that link their nests to their feeding areas. The clearly visible muddy appearance of these tubes is a compelling indicator of termite activity, demanding immediate intervention.

It is crucial that this tree be felled as soon as possible to address the situation effectively, infestation can cause large limbs to fall and a significant amount of rot can even cause the tree to fall.
