On behalf of our client, MCPI (Jersey) Limited, please find enclosed an application for temporary food stalls within Hand Court that forms part of Mid City Place.

Summary

Hand Court is a largely unused and under-utilised space that was formed upon the construction of Mid City Place. It is a hard surfaced area that currently provides for a small number of bike stands. The proposed use of the space for a food market every Thursday between 11.30am-2.30pm seeks to enliven the space and encourage people to eat locally while spending time in the area. This is a similar concept to many that have been approved and successfully operated by KERB across Camden and the City of London.

Policy TC6 of the adopted Local Plan supports the principle of new markets of varying scales noting that locally sourced food and specialist foods from ethnic communities can bring together local resident and working communities where the markets are well managed.



The operator, KERB has a well established legacy with a collective of 158 of the country's newest and most exciting street food businesses. Their flagship food hall is housed within the Seven Dials Market in Camden and they also currently operate at 5 weekly market venues around London as well as at events and venues across the UK. This year this have supported 52 new businesses as part of their incubator programme, supported 220 businesses through their coaching programme and have supported 20 individuals into paid employment roles across the KERB network.
