We object to planning application 2022/0419/T to remove two six-story high plane trees at 8 Doughty Street.

We object to all similar applications in the future.

The objections the previous planning application (2020/5587/T) resulted in Tree Protection Orders being placed on both trees.

Reasons for our objection include

- The trees are an asset to the local community, Camden, and London at large.
- Plane trees help remove air pollution and airborne particulates.
- There is a local ecosystem created by the trees that supports significant wildlife.
- Keeping the trees is an opportunity to help combat the climate crisis.

- Removal of the trees would be harmful to the character and appearance of a conservation area.
- Keeping the trees is in line with Council policies.
- The trees are highly visible locally and from as far as the London Eye.
- The trees contribute to positive mental health for residents the area.

- The applicants (still) haven't fully carried out the recommendations of their surveyors.
- Removal of the trees may cause ground-heave damage to neighbouring properties.
- Three structural engineers advised against removal of the trees in 2020.

- There are engineering solutions to keep the trees in harmony with the building in Doughty Mews that have not been explored by the applicants.

- No planning application should be approved until these alternative solutions are fully explored with architects and surveyors.

We object to planning application 2022/0419/T to remove two six-story high plane trees at 8 Douglas Street, and object to all similar applications in the future, for the reasons on cover sheet.
