The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

#### Reason(s) for Refusal

The details submitted in accordance with condition 4 of planning permission ref. 2020/4714/P dated 10/05/2021, are insuffient to demonstrate that the proposed development would not have an adverse impact on existing trees and the character and amenity of the area, contrary to policies A2 (Open Space) and A3 (Biodiversity) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017 and policies SD2 (Redington Frognal Conservation Area), BG1 (Gardens and Ecology) and BG2 (Tree planting and preservation) of the Redington Frognal Neighbourhood Plan 2021.

# Informative(s):

- 1 You are reminded that conditions 4 (Tree Protection), 6 (Living Roof), and 8 (Lighting) of planning permission 2020/4714/P consent granted on 10/05/2021 are outstanding and require details to be submitted and approved.
- You are advised that in order to enable the Council to discharge this condition the tree protection measures need to demonstrate accordance with BS5837:2012 as required by condition 4. It is suggested that the applicant engages a arboricultural consultant to devise an appropriate tree protection plan which should be informed by an accompanying arboricultural method statement.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2021.
