Assessment

The S.211 notification is to reduce the lateral growth of a tree in the rear garden of a private residence on Merton Lane, which falls within the Highgate Village Conservation Area. The aspect of the canopy to be pruned is overhanging an adjacent property on Fitzroy Park.

The only response received is concerned with the timing of the operation.

The Council requires that all works are carried out according to industry best practice, namely British Standard 3998:2010 (Tree Work: Recommendations).

The Council does not object to the proposed works.
