Advice from Eton Conservation Area Advisory Committee: 05.08.2024

Re St Saviour's Parish Church Eton Road London NW3 4SU: 2024/2972/T

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Sycamore (T1) - Fell to ground level. 1 x Pyracantha (T2) - Lift crown over pavement to 2.5m from ground level

The sketch plan submitted with this application is poor, making it difficult to identify the sycamore tree (T1) which it is intended to fell to ground level. Having puzzled over the sketch and the accompanying photograph, we believe that the tree concerned is the self-seeded one growing hard-by the vestry. If this is the case there is no objection to its removal. But if it is the larger mature tree in the vicarage garden fronting Eton Villas then we would object.

There is no objection to the trimming of the pyracantha next to the entrance gate on Eton Villas since it is overhanging the pavement.

We would like Camden to address the quality of the drawings which are now being submitted with applications, for planning and listed building consent and for tree works. Frequently they are of poor quality lacking relevant details such as dimensions or, as in this case, hand-drawn sketches which make it difficult to establish what is intended.
