

Sempergreen sedum-mix mat, a pre-grown sedum mix blanket containing a mix of 6-8 sedum types. At least 95% sedum coverage on delivery.

Inspect the Sedum roof at least twice a year for weeds and seeds (carried by the wind) and remove this unwanted vegetation manually. Do this preferably in spring and autumn. To encourage biodiver- sity, we do not recommend the use of chemical pesticides. In addition, check whether the drainage system is still functioning properly. Remove any leaves blown into the gutters and

An extensive green roof must be fertilized twice a year. The best period for fertilizing your Sedum roof is late April and early September. The fertilization ensures an even supply of nutrients,

## 3. Irrigation

A well-rooted Sedum roof requires no additional water. Only under very dry conditions is it necessary to provide the green roof with water.
