We have the following comments on this application.

We are **resident neighbours**, and we our comments constitute an **objection**.

The latest version of the application appears to be the same as the previous one, except for the removal of the (only recently added) light screens around the skylights. The removal of the screens (which were intended to reduce light pollution) makes the latest iteration of the application somewhat worse than the previous one. In other respects, the revised application does nothing to address any of the very substantial objections previously lodged by or on behalf of the owners of numbers 50 and 51 Downshire Hill, which we continue to support.
