All operators of radio equipment are responsible for ensuring compliance with a plethora of regulations and guidelines and of specific note is the 'Code of Best Practice on Mobile Network Development in England' and the 'International Commission on Non-Ionising Radiation Protection (ICNIRP) guidelines'.

As a matter of course, UIC adheres to the principles of the Code of Practice, where appropriate, and is committed to complying with relevant government requirements and guidance in terms of electromagnetic field exposure. In summary, this means we fully comply with the International Commission on Non-Ionizing Radiation Protection public exposure levels guidance: continue to ensure all our sites are compliant with this guidance and conformity with the International Commission on Non-Ionizing Radiation Protection. Appendix 1 provides an example of our declaration template which would apply to any of Hubs installed.

UIC will comply with its licenses and transmitter obligations, operating in full accordance with the conditions and legal obligations in respect of interference to other radio systems, and as such will not cause significant and irremediable interference with other electrical equipment, air traffic services or instrumentation operated in the national interest.
