Over this time I have witnessed the many issues that have arisen when development work in back gardens has been allowed to go ahead. We are living on a hill, the houses and their foundations are not entirely stable and the issue has been made worse by the damage that the tree roots has done, particularly to the houses lower down the Terrace. Whilst the proposed works are being considered I would suggest that the current state of the surrounding buildings and the ground immediately underneath should be very carefully examined. There are a number of outstanding insurance claims for houses at the bottom of the Terrace, near the Pub. More excavation of earth from behind the house can only lead to increased danger of further damage to the houses.</p>
