



Wildflower Roof

The maintenance on a wildflower roof is usually combined with a roof inspection and is as follows:

A minimum of 2 visits per year, one in Spring and one in Autumn.

Spring visit is to get the roof ready for the upcoming season, top dress and reseed any areas with low growth and a general tidy up of the whole area.

Autumn visit is to cut down all the plants and leave them on the deck to allow for the seed heads to burst and disperse and then return to the site in a couple of days to pick up and dispose of the arisings.

During every visit remove all unwanted vegetation and any tree saplings, check for free-flowing gutters and clear all outlets if required.
