I totally echo the comments made by Jakki in her attached letter and in addition, the bullet which I would like to highlight are as follows:

- The area and height of the proposed summerhouse/garden pavilion are excessive, it already is, and will continue to have a negative impact on my back garden and those of my neighbours. The proximity of the structure to my boundary wall is too overbearing, oppressive and inodorous.
- The proximity of the structure feels like it is encroaching on my personal space and privacy. When I first purchased my property, within a conservation area made me feel very comfortable that new builds would not occur that will have an impact
