20 Redington Road: 2024/2871/P - follow-up objection

Thank you for updating the Neighbourhood Forum on the latest thinking about re modelling the wooded front garden at 20 Redington Road.

The Neighbourhood Forum shares the aims of the Tree Officer and would similarly support replacement planting with more native species and greater density close to the highway.

However, for compliance with the Neighbourhood Plan, the following information is additionally requested:

- areas of hard surface and natural soft surface, as exitsting and as proposed, quantified in square metres;
- number and species and locations of trees and shrubs proposed, in mitigation of:
 - the number of felled trees and shrubs
 - o any increase in the area of hard surface
 - o any decrease in the area of natural soft surface.

Appropriate planting to benefit native biodiversity (in accordance with policy BGI 1 i and ii) is set out in section 6.2.2 of the Neighbourhood Plan.
