> kitchen windows when this development commences No consultation with

> us has taken a place This has not been considered the residents

> tenants of 63 Fitzjohns Avenue should have been consulted as this

> development will cause a nuisance and distress not only noise

> pollution dust pollution our privacy will also be affected with the

> development being able to directly look in to our homes also this will

> obstruct our views Our objection is first count noise pollution second

> account dust inconvenience with refuse collections privacy Obstruction

> of the road with resident parking the increased traffic along with

> the school run will be unbearable and calls a great deal of

> inconvenience and distress. The road is very narrow. There is only

> room for one car at a time to drive down the road lorries will block

> the road again, causing frustration and noise from aggravated drivers

> our peace and quiet will be greatly disturbed by this construction if

> it is allowed to go through along with the vibration after work

> finally the construction of the dwelling which will directly overlook

> our garden. This will mean looking directly into our homes invading

> privacy more importantly blocking our view. This is invading our green

> space
