#### Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Cherry (T1) - Reduce overhang on North side of the crown by up to 2.5m.  
1 x Indian Bean (T2) - Raise crown to 4.5m above garden level and thin whole crown by up to 20%.  
1 x Sweet Gum (T3) - Fell to ground level.  
1 x Horse Chestnut (T4) - Reduce overhang on North side of the crown by up to 2.5m.  
1 x Purple Wild Plum (T5 - T8) - Reduce down to 5m above garden level and shape in as necessary.  
1 x Purple Wild Plum (T9) - Reduce crown on the south side by up to 1m.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 02 August 2024 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these

standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.

- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife. Of particular note is the protection offered to bats, birds and their nests from construction works.
