To Camden Council:

I am a homeowner: Palace Court: we live in the garden flat. I am deeply concerned to learn about the plans to develop the garages next to our building: in fact the garages are directly facing my windows and little garden: the only small piece of freedom, air, sky and green we have. I am voicing my utmost and strongest rejection to the development. This development is nothing, but a death sentence to our home.

Can I draw your attention to the following points:

Loss of Privacy

Overlooking Issues: Balconies and terraces are too close to our property. In fact, they will be directly looking into our kitchen, dining/sitting room and my little daughter's bedroom.

Direct View Concerns: The current positioning of balconies allows direct views of us as a Family of 5 (me , wife and 3 girls) sitting outside on our terrace enjoying some tranquility and a bit of fresh air

Daylight and Sunlight Reduction

Negative Impact on Natural Light: Our windows are north/west facing the garden: and the only source of light we have comes from where the garages are: having a building erected will mean: we will be living in a bunker!! darkness!! and doom.

Structural Stability and Ground Conditions

Slope Stability and Groundwater Flow Risks: The extensive basement excavation poses risks to our property due to potential ground movement

and slope instability, which will surely cause subsidence. We have had soil movements/subsidence in 2016 which affected the building. Further digging in the area will threaten both: Ashley Court and Palace Court: subsidence/cracks and potential collapse!!

Drainage and Water Management Issues: in 2022/23 we had major drainage issues caused by soil movements: sewage water from Ashly court (building adjacent to carages) started leaking into our back garden. This has been rectified. I am sure any further digging / movements in the area will cause sewage to flood our building.

And finally: I am astonished to see the unlawful campaign the developer is making to promote their proposal !!!

They are even gathering support from people, who don't even live in the neighborhood!! and will never be affected directly by the development!!
