## Informative(s):

1 Reasons for granting approval:

The submitted details of the planting to be installed on either side of the roof terrace are considered to be acceptable to discharge condition 5.

The applicant proposes to install Portuguese Laurel hedges within planter boxes which would be tall (1.8m high) and evergreen. This is considered appropriate to provide an acceptable level of privacy to the adjacent roof terraces.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed during the determination of the original application.
