Thank you for consulting TfL this application, TfL offers the following comments:

1. It is understood that the section of the footway is heavily trafficked by pedestrians during weekends/ holidays as it is opposite Stable Market and near Camden Market, therefore Camden Council shall consider whether the proposal would cause an adverse impact to pedestrian level of service (LOS) during the peak time for this part of the area.
2. TfL ask that the Council to consider the acceptability of the proposal on whether or not it contribute positively toward an 'Healthy Street' environment in line with London Policy T2 and not causing additional street clutter on the street.
