The Council has considered your application dated 04 July 2024 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

- 1 This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
 - Reason: To allow the Local planning authority to monitor the completion and standards of the work.
- 2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)

Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).

Between the November and March following the removal of the trees, two London plane (Platanus x acerifolia) trees with a stem circumference of 14-16cm at 1m above the top of the root ball shall be planted in the rear garden of the property no less than 2 metres from any above ground structure and no less than two metres between each tree. The trees shall be planted and maintained in accordance with the standard set out it BS8545:2014.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
