We have recently been made aware of the application to develop Coal Drops Yard further by adding a new pavilion. It has been highlighted to us by 'Save Coal Drops Yard' that this may remove the opportunity for temporary events and public arts uses in the existing public realm. We would like to highlight that many of these have been cultural events that have contributed to supporting the wider cultural ecosystem that exists within Kings Cross and the SME maker ecosystem in London. Of particular note was the Hemmingway Design led, 'The Drops' market which showcased emerging designers across fashion, homewares and lifestyle, complementing Central St. Martins industry leading fashion courses.
