Details of the pre-application advice received
The proposed extension would result in an increase to the size of Flats 1 and 3, which are existing studio flats. The site is a non-designated heritage asset within the Camden Town Conservation Area. The Council has a statutory obligation to preserve or enhance the character and appearance of the conservation area, to which the subject site makes a positive contribution. The site is visible from other houses in the conservation area, and also in public views from Harrington Square/Hurdwick Place to the rear. The proposed development would be visible from such views. The existing rear elevation of this area of Eversholt Street contains a few smaller single storied extensions at first floor level to the rear, however there are no extensions of a similar scale to that proposed present within the surrounding area. In fact, there are no rear extensions within the area granted under current planning policy and guidance. The proposed extension would be out of character with the prevailing pattern of development in this location, with respect to its scale, width and depth. The second-floor extension would add excessive bulk, and would mask the characteristic diagonal arrangement of windows that the rear of these properties display. The proposed windows are of a single-light type that is uncharacteristic of the conservation area and would not be supported by Council. Windows should take a traditional form and match existing in design and materiality. The brickwork to match the existing is appropriate. The green roof is a welcome addition; details could be provided at the time of application, or could be secured via condition. The black steel balustrades are considered appropriate, however their location should be clearly identified on the proposed first floor plan. Overall, Council is not supportive of the proposed development from a heritage and design perspective. The scale is out of character with the prevailing pattern of development along this area of Eversholt Street, and would be harmful to the character and ap
