

Figure 03 displays three plant species recommended for the green roof, each with a photograph and a detailed description.

***Sedum album* 'Coral Carpet'**  
An evergreen, mat-forming perennial with small, succulent, rounded green leaves flushed with red. Star-shaped white flowers are borne in clusters above the foliage in early summer.

***Sedum spurium* green-flowered**  
Caucasian stonecrop  
A vigorous, mat-forming, semi-evergreen perennial to 10cm tall, with fleshy, toothed leaves held on spreading, rooting stems. Star-shaped, pink or white flowers are produced in rounded clusters in late summer.

***Sedum spathulifolium***  
spoon-leaved stonecrop  
A mat-forming evergreen perennial to 6cm tall, with thick, obovate, silvery-grey leaves tinged with purple, and sprays of starry yellow flowers in summer.

***Sedum acre* 'Golden Queen'**  
biting stonecrop 'Golden Queen'  
A succulent, mat-forming, evergreen perennial to about 5cm tall. The overlapping, triangular leaves are light yellow-green, pale yellow at the shoot tips. Bright yellow, star-shaped flowers appear throughout the summer.

***Sedum acre***  
biting stonecrop  
A mat-forming, hairless, succulent perennial with small, ovoid, fleshy leaves close to the stems. Flowers are five-petalled, yellow and star shaped. They bloom from May to July. Bees enjoy its nectar.
